Issue Five of the Plato journal of the International Plato Society opens with a contribution by Béatrice Bakhouché on Calcidius, and one by David Konstan on the Ion. Then follow five contributions that were presented at a workshop on Plato's Statesman at the University of Notre Dame in September of 2004 (not all the papers were submitted for publication). These contributions are by Catherine Zuckert, Kenneth Sayre, Christopher Rowe, and David Roochnik. David Roochnik's paper is followed by a response from George Harvey. A paper by Terry Penner on the Republic closes this section of the journal. In the review section we have an assessment by Maria Dzielska of Dominic J. O'Meara *Platonopolis. Platonic Political Philosophy in Late Antiquity*.

All submissions are refereed (anonymously) by expert readers, including a native or fluent speaker of the language of the article.

The next deadline for submission of contributions is end of September 2005.
